2018 Party Reorganization

During the Primary Election on May 8, 2018, every single seat on the MCDP Central Committee will be on the ballot. To run for Central Committee you must pick up a petition at the Board of Elections office in the County Building, our office at 313 S. Jefferson St., Dayton, or by printing out the form from the Board of Elections website.

1. In a reorganization year, every single member of the Central Committee must run
2. You must be a resident of the precinct in which you are running
3. You need to pick up a petition from either the Board of Elections, our office, or print it from the Board of Elections website. The petition must be signed by 5 registered Democrats from your precinct
4. Petitions are due to the Board of Elections by 4 p.m. on February 7, 2018
5. Precinct elections are on the Primary ballot. The 2018 Primary is on May 8, 2018

6. To vote in Precinct elections, you must request a Democratic ballot (*incidentally, selecting a Democratic ballot in a primary is the only way to be a "registered Democrat" in the state of Ohio*)

7. After the May primary, the current Central Committee is dissolved, and the newly elected Central Committee undertakes the Reorganization process wherein leadership is selected, an audit conducted, and our governing documents are reviewed. ONLY ELECTED PRECINCT CAPTAINS MAY PARTICIPATE IN THIS PROCESS.

8. Once reorganization is completed, the Central Committee may appoint additional Precinct Captains in unfilled precincts.
