MCDP Votes Early!

Early voting is underway in Ohio, and even though the legislature has made it less convenient over the years, we should still strive to cast an early ballot.

- Precinct Captains: Voting now allows you to experience the early voting process first hand, so you can better explain it to other voters as you canvass your neighborhoods.
- Campaign volunteers: You can alleviate the stress of trying to vote on election day as you work to elect your chosen candidates.
- For Everyone: You could be ill, called into work, or have an emergency on election day. There is no way to know. Vote now, and ensure your ballot is counted no matter what May 8th brings.

In Ohio, there are two ways to vote before election day. You can vote by mail with an absentee ballot or you can vote early in-person at an absentee voting location.

To vote by mail: Simply request a ballot by filling out an application.

1. Visit montgomerydems.org and scroll to the bottom to click "Vote Absentee".
2. Follow the link to the application form to download and print.
3. Send your application to the Board of Elections at the address provided.
4. When it arrives, fill out and mail the ballot back, or drop it off at the county Board of Elections.
5. BE AWARE: Your completed ballot may need more than one first class stamp.

To vote early in person: Visit the Montgomery County Board of Elections on

one of the dates listed in the box below to cast your ballot. Ensure that you have identification with you when you go to vote, including the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number.

Precinct Captain elections are the very last spot on your ballot, so make sure you vote in every single office all the way to the end! And if you are running for precinct captain in your own precinct, make sure you vote for yourself - even if you are unopposed. This is especially important for write-in candidates. It's amazing how many times modesty has kept a Precinct Captain from getting elected!
